United Healthcare To Be New TRICARE West Contractor The Government Accountability Office (GAO) announced this week that it was moving ahead with its decision to award the Tricare West region (T-3) contract to United Healthcare. The contract had been held by TriWest Healthcare Alliance, who had filed a protest with GAO earlier this year. TriWest currently serves 2.9 million beneficiaries, including active duty personnel, retirees and their families, and has more than 175,000 healthcare providers in its 21-state network. Their current contract continues through March 31, 2013, after which United Healthcare will take over beginning April 1, 2013.
